

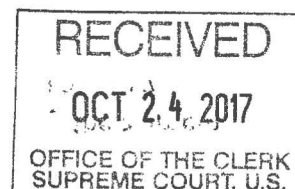
This will acknowledge notification of the order entered by the Supreme Court concerning the above-referenced petition for writ of mandamus on October 10, 2017.


